



Jazreel Low is an award-winning composer, arranger, producer, and classically trained pianist. She is currently completing her final year of a BA(Hons) Music specializing in Composition and Arranging at the School of Contemporary Music, LASALLE College of the Arts in Singapore. Jazreel has been creating and performing music for nearly a decade, including attaining the Trinity ATCL Diploma in Piano Performance, regularly taking prominent roles in her CCA music groups at Junior College, and performing for the renowned pianist and Steinway Artist, Dr. Steven Spooner.

After settling into her leadership role as Music Director of Music Club at Junior College, which involved composing, making arrangements and conducting rehearsals, she realized that what started out as a Co-Curricular Activity was turning into what could potentially be a career. Her commitment to her craft earned her the Outstanding Contribution Award given by the school.

Jazreel's composition style is heavily influenced by Japanese animations, as well as a variety of concert band works by Japanese composers she was exposed to during her time in secondary school as part of their concert band. Although her works are mainly tonal, she does like to occasionally express a bit of atonality with use of extended techniques in achieving a specific tone for her piece.

Jazreel composes works in a multitude of genres, ranging from classical contemporary to pop to orchestral works and jazz, as she finds herself on a journey to find her compositional voice.

In addition, her works have been performed by the internationally acclaimed Mandelring String Quartet (Germany) during their artist in residence programme at LASALLE in 2017 and is currently completing a new commission for the Sembawang Wind Orchestra. Jazreel recently won first place at the Six Strings Studio: "Melody of Love Songwriting Competition" in September, 2018.
